


Student ArcGIS Desktop (Windows) Installation Guide


1. Navigate to this form: <https://go.unimelb.edu.au/v2je>

Sign in with your University of Melbourne student email.



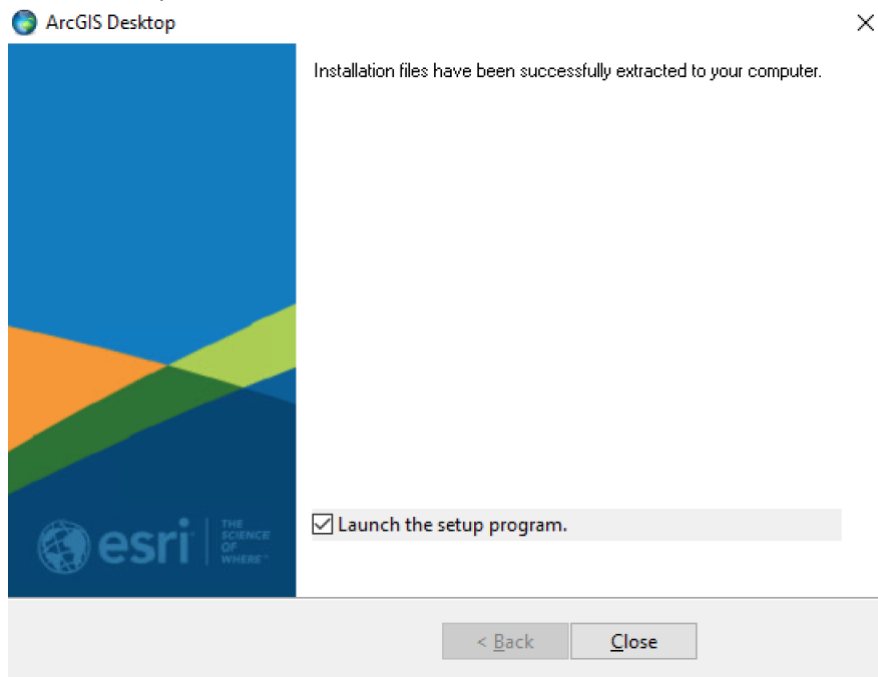

2. Review the **Terms and Conditions** and press **Submit** to continue.

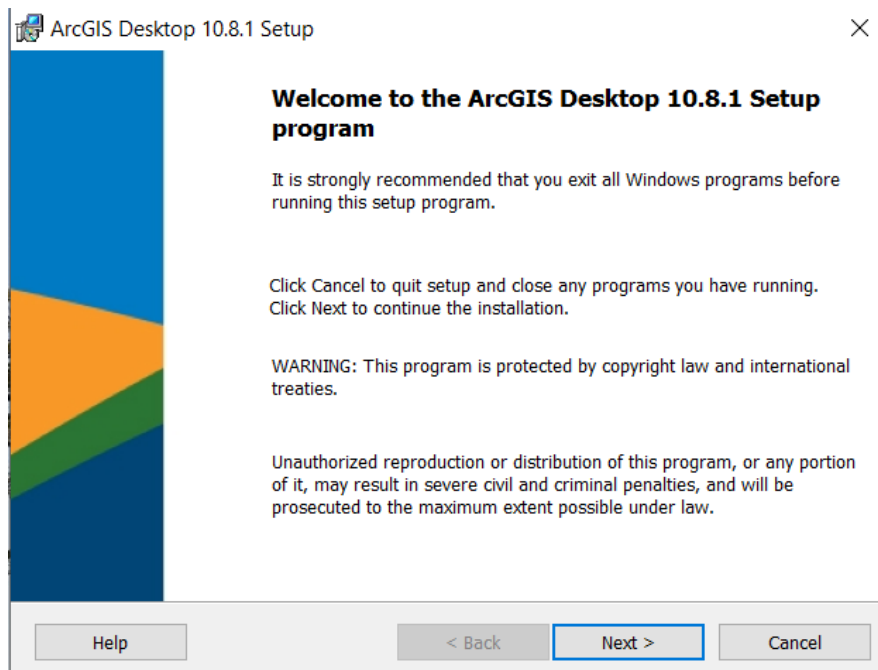

5. Follow through with the prompts to extract the installation files. The setup program should automatically launch.



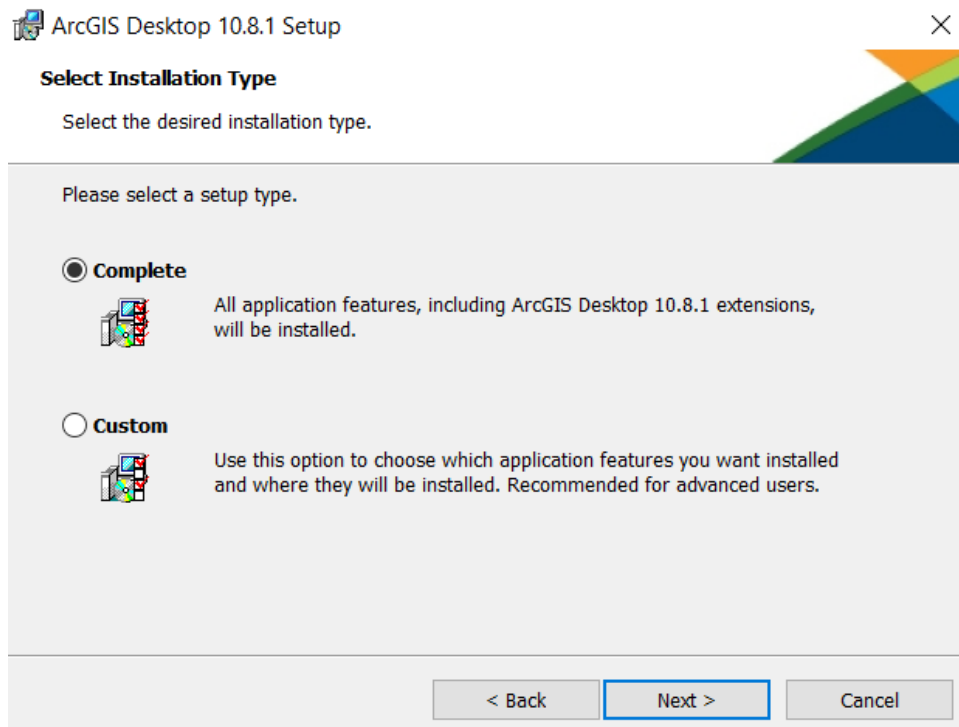
6. Click **Next** to run through the Setup program.



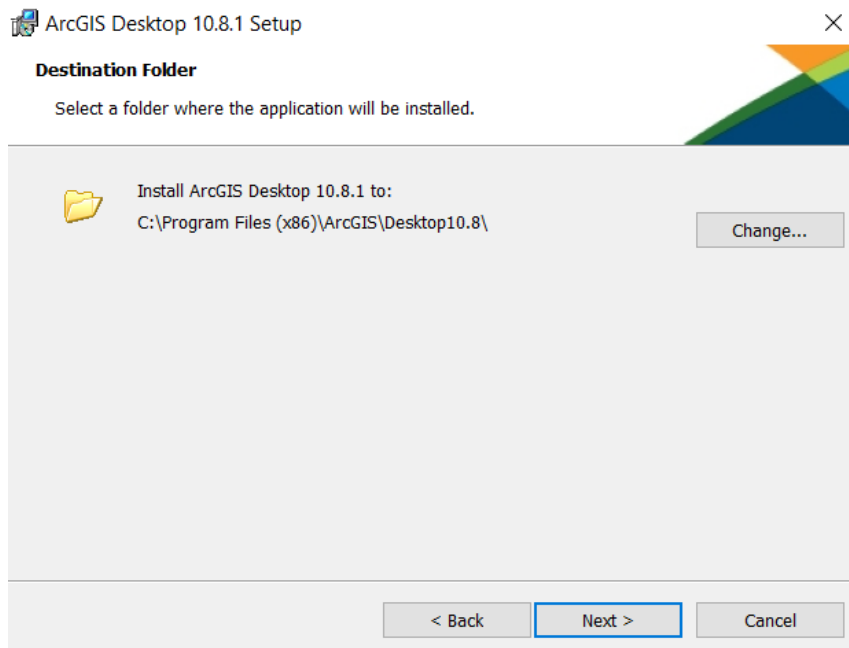
7. Review the master agreement then click **Next** to continue.



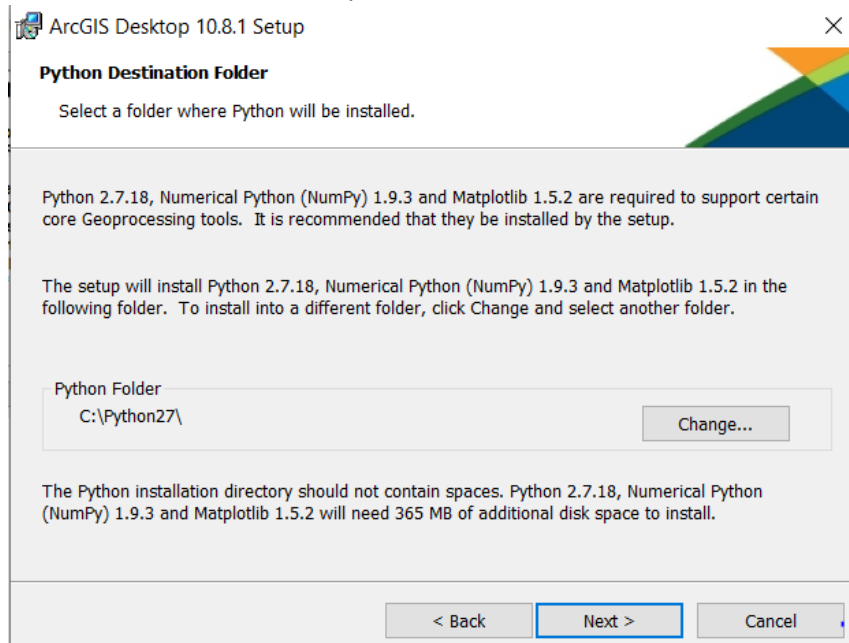
8. Select **Complete** as the installation type, then click **Next**.



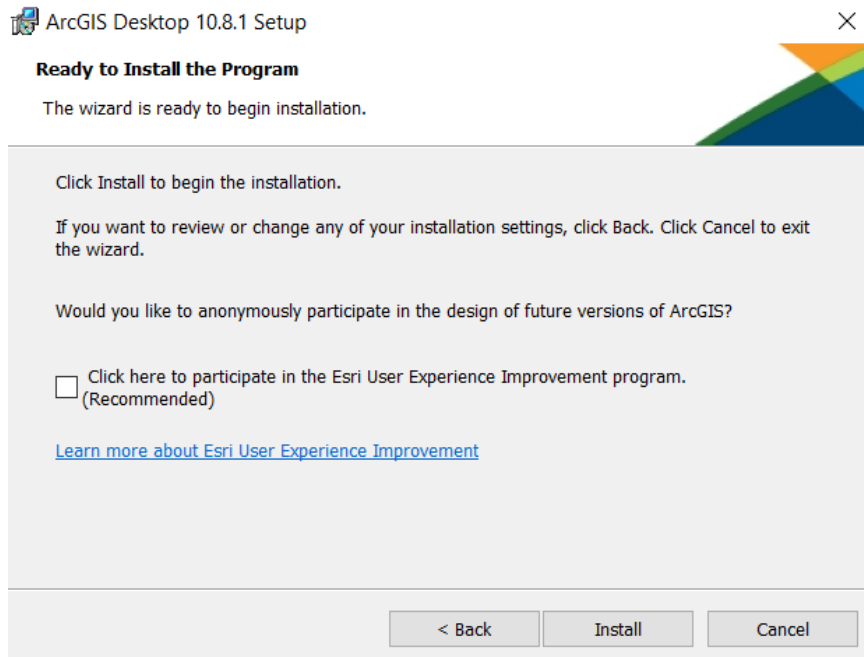
9. Select a destination folder where the application will be installed, then click **Next**.



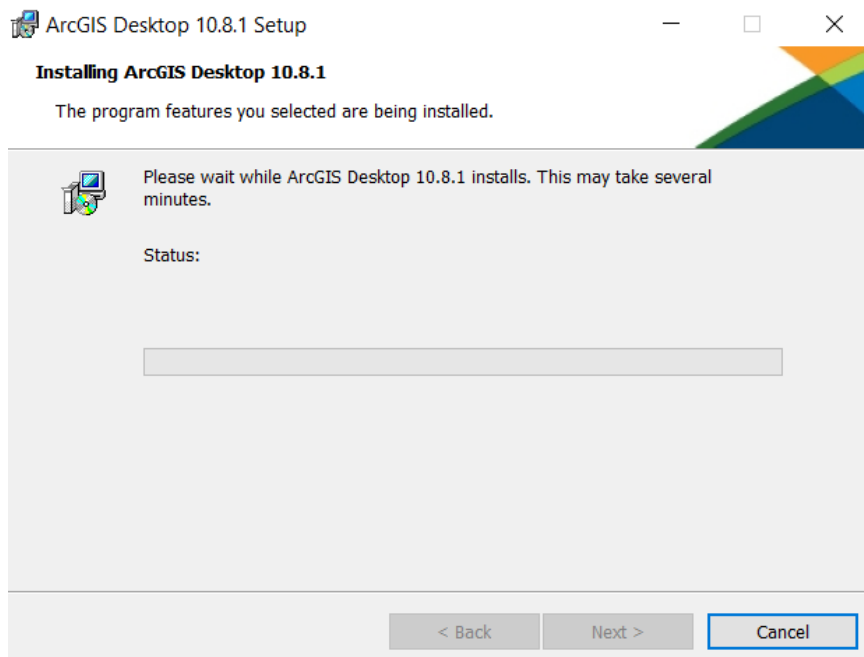
10. Select a destination where Python will be installed, then click **Next**.



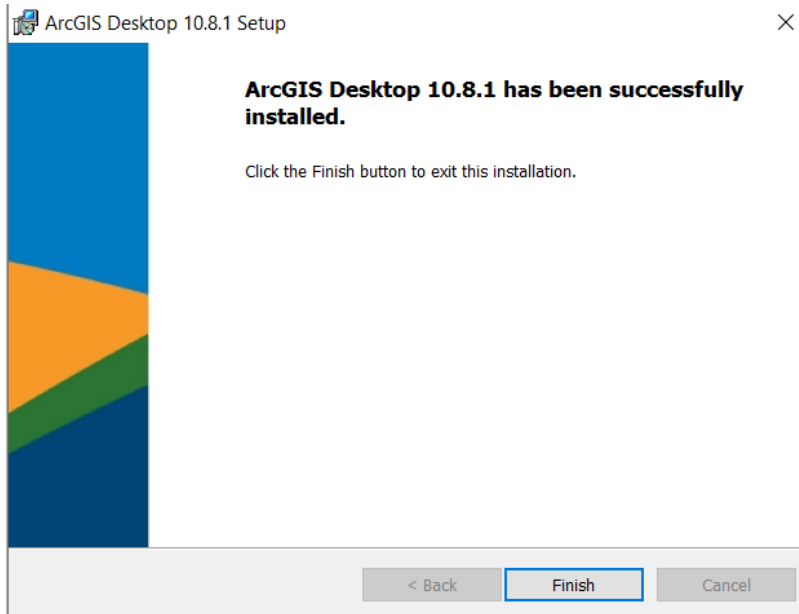
11. Click **Install** to begin the installation.



12. Wait for the program to be installed. This may take some time.

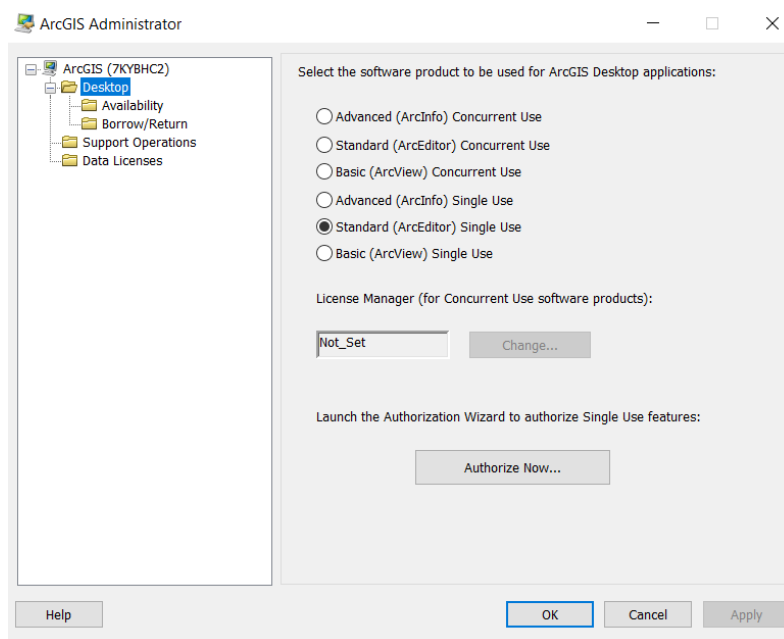


13. Click **Finish** to close the installer.



14. After running the program, a login window will pop up. Please click the 'Configure your licensing options' button.

- a. Alternatively, search for ArcGIS Administrator and select **Desktop** as per the screenshot below. Select the relevant "Single Use" license and then click "Authorize Now..."



15. Select 'I have installed my software and need to authorize it' and click **Next**.

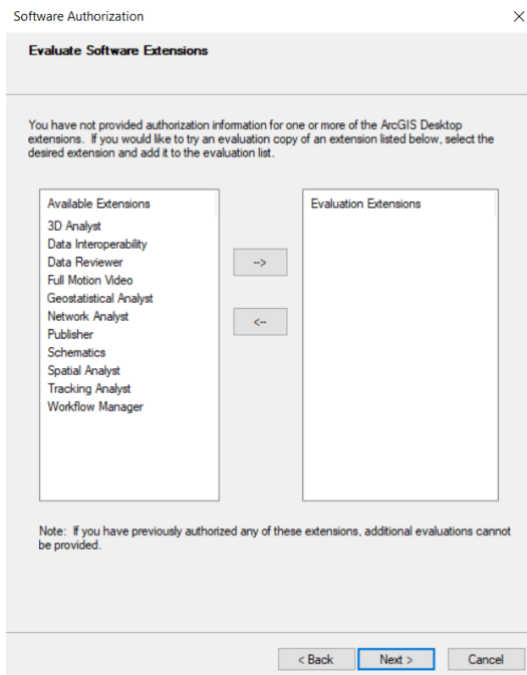
