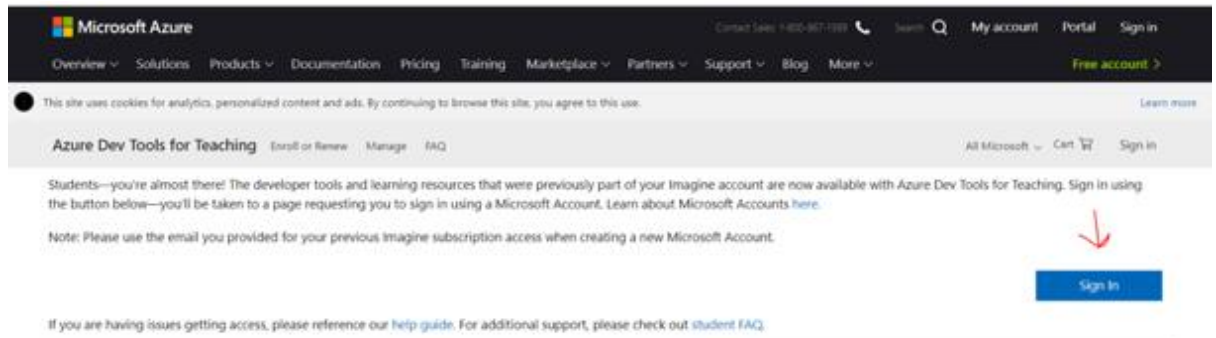
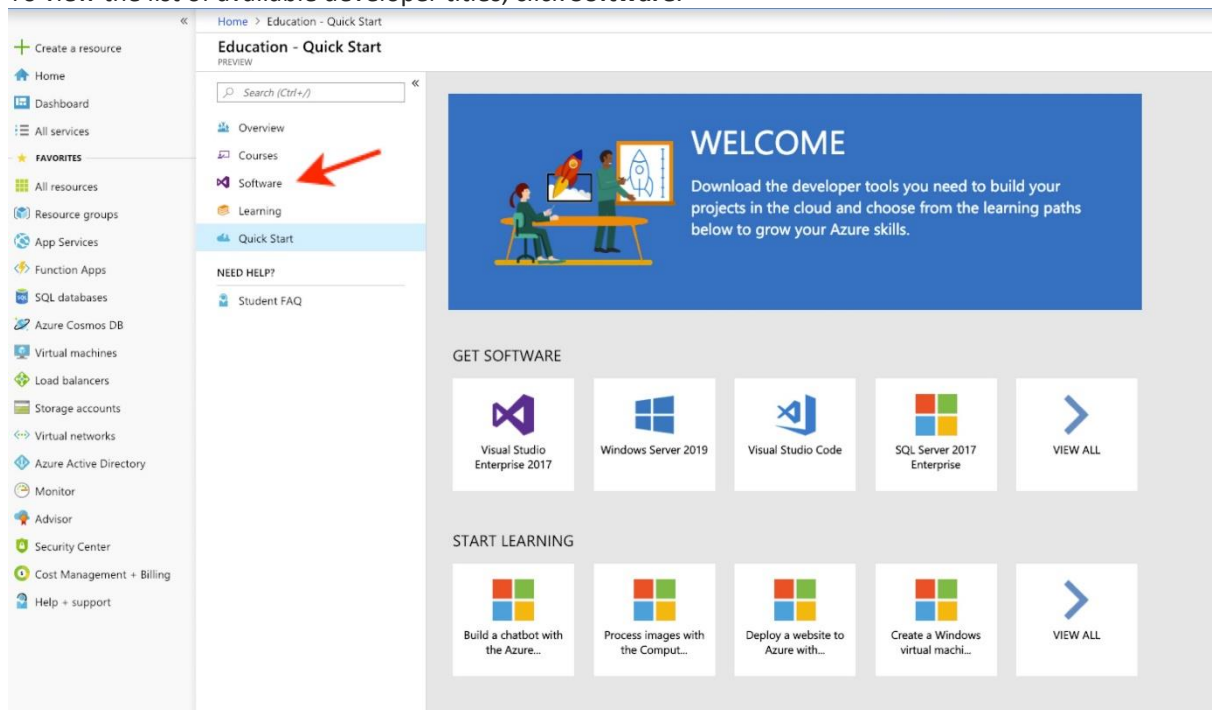


Getting started with Azure Dev Tools for Teaching

1. Visit the [Azure Dev Tools for Teaching website](#) and click **Sign In**.



2. If this is the first time you've logged in, you will need to enter your university Email address and password at the Microsoft login prompt, then click **Next**.
3. When prompted, log in using your university email and password.
4. Tick the **Subscription Agreement** box, then click **Accept terms**.
5. First time visitors can choose to take a brief tour.
6. To view the list of available developer titles, click **Software**.



To get the activation Key

1. Select a software title, then click **View Key**
2. Copy the Key

To download software

3. Select a software title, then click **Download** or **Activate**.
4. Follow any onscreen prompts to complete your download.

- From the upper right-hand corner, click your account profile.
- From the drop-down menu, click **Sign out**, then close the browser session.
